Our new start and finish line will be located at Sawyer Point, just east of The Purple People Bridge near the P&G Pavilion! From our start, riders will travel along the banks of the Ohio River via Riverside Drive, through the Historic East End. Our riders will utilize the designated bicycle lanes located along this route. At the first Turnaround/Rest Stop, 10-mile riders will return while 15-mile riders continue around the Lunken Airport Trail. 24, 36, and 64-mile riders will connect directly to the Little Miami Scenic Trail via the NEW Bechmont Bridge Connector from the Lunken Airport Trail.

From here each distance is an out-and-back ride along the Little Miami Scenic Trail. Depending upon distance chosen, riders will pass through Newtown, Milford, Miami, and finally reach the final Turnaround/Rest Stop in Kings Mills at the historic Peters Cartridge Factory, a local landmark.
